Including Partners for Youth Empowerment in your Estate Plan

"In the event that at some future time due to changed circumstances, in the judgment of the Commonweal Board of Directors, it becomes impractical to apply my bequest to the designated purpose(s), the t Commonweal Board of Directors shall make such modifications as will appropriately recognize my interests in coordination with Partners for Youth Empowerment priorities."
